

REVOLVING DOORS

Consists of three or four leaves that rotate about a central, vertical pivot a cylindrically shaped vestibule. used typically as entrance doors in large commercial and institutional buildings, revolving doors provide a continuous weather seal, eliminate drafts, hold heating and cooling losses to a minimum while accommodating traffic up to 2000 persons per hour.
